

Feature Update June 2022

New Features:

1. New dashboard available for clients at director-level.
2. Clients can brand the ComplianceGO webapp.
3. Customizable login page specific to your company.

Enhancements:

- Added individualized scheduling for future calendar events.
- Added additional notifications for action items assigned to individuals.
- Enhanced the “All Action Items” and individual “Action Items” pages.
- Added an “Identifier” field on action items to allow for enhanced tracking.
- For self-signups, when a site is created, the user is now added as an inspector to the site.
- For self-signups, three sample forms will now be added to the company automatically to aid with start-up.
- Added quick access letters that allow you to jump to any letter on the site list on most dashboards.
- Streamlined photo upload process to allow for more pictures to be uploaded simultaneously.
- Added quick access letters on the site list on the dashboard.
- Added a “To Top” button to the site list on the dashboard.
- Changed the “Sites / Divisions” toggle and the “Show Inactive” on the dashboard site list to float as you scroll.

Bug Fixes:

- Fixed an issue that was reducing upload performance on Apple devices.
- Fixed sites not loading on dashboards for some clients.
- Fixed mobile issues with the footer on the self-sign up page as well as in the app.
- Fixed an incorrect color on the weather thresholds page.
- Fixed an issue that was causing the “Forward” and “Back” buttons on the Inspections Calendar to not function for mobile users.
- Fixed an issue that caused scroll bars to disappear.
- Fixed an issue where action items would not appear immediately when added to an inspection.
- Fixed an issue where the search results would not scroll on mobile devices.
- Fixed site names starting with special characters making duplicate entries in the site list.
- Fixed an issue that caused the Forward and Back buttons to not work on mobile devices.
- Fixed an issue that caused a note added to an action item to appear on all action items temporarily.
